Governance & Sovereignty

Constitutions, codes, ethics, elections, records, institutional design, and governmental authority.

Business & Development

Entity formation, governance, contracting, project structure, risk allocation, and intergovernmental coordination.

Grants & Compliance

Award terms, administration, procurement, documentation, behavioral-health initiatives, and federal requirements.

Litigation & Appeals

Jurisdiction, sovereign immunity, statutory rights, institutional interests, and appellate strategy.

Resources & Environment

Consultation, land and resource questions, administrative process, governmental authority, and project review.

Intergovernmental Advocacy

Engagement with federal, state, local, and Tribal decision-makers on law, policy, and shared priorities.

At this time, All Rise! represents Tribal governments only in Indian Child Welfare proceedings.

How we work

- 1 Start with the Nation's law, objective, decision-makers, and deadlines.
- 2 Separate confirmed facts, public authority, operational constraints, and legal judgment.
- 3 Define scope, responsible counsel, communication, fees, and any needed local or specialized support in writing.

Start with conflicts, fit, scope, and the next known deadline.
